Subject: **Authorization to Accept NYSDCJS Crime Prevention Grant Funding**

1. **Action Requested:** The Tompkins County Sheriff's Office received grant monies in 2016 totaling **\$10,000** from the New York State Division of Criminal Justice. These monies were not utilized in 2016. The Sheriff's Office now wishes to carry forward **\$10,000** of that grant funding into 2017.
2. **Background:** In 2016, the New York State Division of Criminal Justice Crime Prevention Grant was awarded to the Tompkins County Sheriff's Office for the period of September 1st, 2016 to August 31st, 2017 . This provides grant funding in the amount of **\$10,000**. The funds will be used to purchase law enforcement equipment for the neighborhood watch program and other crime prevention services in Tompkins County. This money was not utilized or accepted in 2016. The primary purchase that will be made with these funds in 2017 is an electric speed sign; which will aid in crime prevention in the community. Other purchases would include: D.A.R.E. supplies, Neighborhood Watch Program supplies, etc...
3. **Financial Implications:** The Tompkins County Sheriff's Office is requesting approval for the grant funds (\$10,000) to be accepted into the 2017 budget and utilized to purchase the aforementioned departmental equipment and supplies.
