Subject: **Authorization to Accept NYSDCJS Crime Prevention Grant Funding**

1. **Action Requested:** The Tompkins County Sheriff's Office received grant monies in 2017 totaling **\$7,500** from the New York State Division of Criminal Justice.

2. **Background:** The New York State Division of Criminal Justice Crime Prevention Grant was awarded to the Tompkins County Sheriff's Office for the period of October 1st, 2017 to September 30, 2018 . This provides grant funding in the amount of **\$7,500**. The funds will be used to purchase digital cameras for the Road Patrol in order to enhance the department's response to the community.

3. **Financial Implications:** The Tompkins County Sheriff's Office is requesting approval for the grant funds (\$7,500) to be accepted into the 2017 budget and utilized to purchase the aforementioned departmental equipment.
